

How to Separate And Put Out Your Waste (英語)

Shigen (Recyclable)

Plastic (PET) bottles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rinse, and place inside blue net • Remove cap and label
Glass bottles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rinse, and place in yellow basket
Spraying cans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Empty all air out, and place in yellow basket
Metal cans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rinse, and place in blue basket or green net
Fabric	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Futons are Oversize Waste • Do not put fabric out if it's raining
Paper	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Includes cardboard and magazines

Shigen Plastic (Recyclable Plastic)

- Quickly rinse, and place in yellow-green net
- If dirty, put in Combustible
- Items over 24cm x 24cm x 35cm are Oversize Waste

Kanen (Combustible)

- Includes food waste and dirty plastics
- Use transparent or semi-transparent bags

Funen (Incombustible), Yuugai (Toxic)

- Includes batteries, glass and metal
- Place batteries in red triangle basket, others in green basket
- Contain any broken glass in a transparent plastic bag
- Items over 24cm x 24cm x 35cm are Oversize Waste

Sodai Gomi (Oversize Waste)

- Items over 24cm x 24cm x 35cm are Oversize Waste
- Contact Oversize Waste Centre for discarding Oversize Waste
