Paper	· Includes cardboard and magazines

Shigen Plastic (Recyclable Plastic)

- · Quickly rinse, and place in yellow-green net
- · If dirty, put in Combustible
- Items over 24cm x 24cm x 35cm are Oversize Waste

Kanen (Combustible)

- Includes food waste and dirty plastics
- Use transparent or semi-transparent bags

Funen (Incombustible), Yuugai (Toxic)

- · Includes batteries, glass and metal
- · Place batteries in red triangle basket, others in green basket
- · Contain any broken glass in a transparent plastic bag
- · Items over 24cm x 24cm x 35cm are Oversize Waste

Sodai Gomi (Oversize Waste)

- Items over 24cm x 24cm x 35cm are Oversize Waste
- · Contact Oversize Waste Centre for discarding Oversize Waste
