

How to Dispose of Trash/Recyclables

- Please cooperate by decreasing and separating recyclables and trash.
- Please **fully drain kitchen waste** before disposing of it.
- Please put your trash/recyclables out **by 8:00 a.m. on the collection day.**

PET bottles		Only clean bottles are accepted. Remove and recycle the lid and label according to what they are made of. Flatten PET bottles before disposing of them. Glass bottles/spray cans		Remove and recycle the lid according to what they are made of. Please rinse out bottles. Please place broken bottles in a transparent plastic bag. Please use spray cans until they are empty, and puncture them if possible before disposal.	Put them in city-designated yellow boxes													
Cans		Please rinse out cans. Please wipe oil cans without rinsing after using up the contents.	Put them in city-designated blue boxes													
Paper		Please put newspaper inserts out with the newspapers. Wet paper cannot be collected. The following types of paper are considered burnable trash: Oil paper, wax paper, carbon paper, foil, heat-sensitive paper, stickers, shredded paper, coated paper	Note: Please bundle these papers together with string. (Do not put them in the collection container at a collection point.)													
Cloth		Futons and large quilted products are considered oversized trash. Clothing with inner linings is considered burnable trash. Wet items cannot be collected. Soiled items are considered burnable trash.	Note: Please place these items into transparent or semitransparent plastic bags. (Do not put them in the collection container at a collection point.)													
Recyclable Plastic		Please lightly rinse these items clean. Items that cannot be cleaned are considered burnable trash. Items made of multiple materials can be either burnable or unburnable trash. Items larger than itto-kan (18-liter cans; 24 cm long x 24 cm wide x 35 cm high) are oversized trash. Burnable Trash		Please fully drain kitchen waste before disposing of it. Please put the human waste in the toilet before disposing of diapers. Please dispose of bags, school bags and belts with metal fittings that cannot be removed as unburnable trash. Unburnable Trash		Please place sewing needles and razor blades in a sealed metal container and write "ケン" (dangerous). Items larger than itto-kan (18-liter cans; 24 cm long x 24 cm wide x 35 cm high) are oversized trash. Please place broken cups and glasses, etc. in a transparent plastic bag. Umbrella canopies are considered burnable trash. Please wrap the blades of kitchen knives you are discarding in towels or paper, and write "ケン" (dangerous) in red ink. Fluorescent lights and mercury thermometers should be placed in their cases before disposal. Button batteries should be taken to the store where you purchase their replacements. Lighters should be disposed of only after the gas inside is used up. 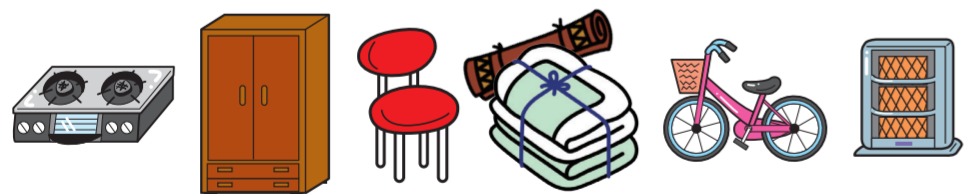
2 Trash with Collection Fees (By request only)

- Please submit requests well in advance of when you need to dispose of your items.
 - You can also submit requests via the city website.

Oversized Trash (items larger than 24 cm long x 24 cm wide x 35 cm high)

Furniture, electronic appliances, etc. from homes

(When possible, have the vendor take these items away when you replace them.)



Collection by reservation

1 Requests are made by phone. (Up to five items may be collected at a time. If you have more than five items, submit another request after collection.) Please give your name, address and phone number, as well as the item's name and its number. Please have a notepad ready to take down the receipt number to write on the voucher.

2 Purchase a trash collection voucher.

Vouchers can be purchased at convenience stores displaying a trash collection "vouchers available" sticker, and at Shiki Station, the Yanasegawa Station Branch Office, the City Hall, etc. The collection fees will be indicated when you make a reservation to have your item picked up. Note: Refunds are not issued for trash collection vouchers. Please note that vouchers from other municipalities cannot be used.

3 Affix a voucher on each piece of oversized trash.

Please remember to write the collection date, receipt number and item name on the voucher.

4 Please put oversized trash outside of your home (within the premises) by 8:30 a.m. (or in the designated oversized trash collection area, if you live in an apartment or condo). You do not need to wait for the trash collectors.

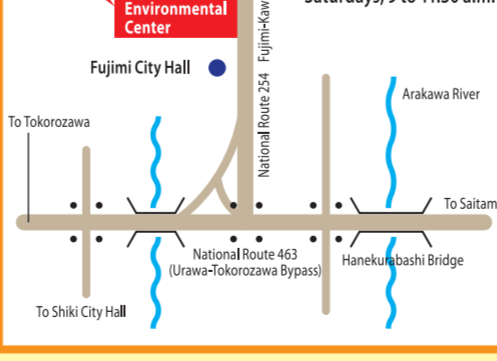
Bringing your items in directly (except on holidays)

- When bringing your items in directly, please call the City Hall for reservations.
- Reservations for your desired dropoff date (Monday through Saturday) are accepted from two weeks in advance.
- Same-day dropoffs are also accepted weekdays.
- Only the first fifteen people can drop off items on Saturdays. (Requests by email are not accepted.)
- Please make sure to remove the kerosene from kerosene stoves, etc.

3 Trash the City Cannot Collect

Trash the City Cannot Collect

Home Appliance Recycling Law	Act on the Promotion of Effective Utilization of Resources	Trash that is difficult to dispose of	Industrial trash
Televisions, air conditioners (including outdoor units), refrigerators and freezers, washing machines and clothes dryers	PCs, monitors, laptop computers	Motorcycles, automotive parts (tires, bumpers, etc.), waste oil, car batteries, bathtubs, blocks, pianos, fire extinguishers, mud, hypodermic needles, medical supplies, stones, bricks, propane tanks, pharmaceuticals, construction waste, vending machines, etc.	Trash generated by business activities (general waste)
Please ask the retailer you purchased your item from or a city-approved contractor to dispose of these items. For more details, please contact the City Hall.	Please apply directly to the manufacturer of your equipment or the PC3R Promotion Association. PC3R Promotion Association Tel: 03-5282-7685	Please contact the retailer or a waste disposal contractor. These items cannot be incinerated, so please hire a waste disposal contractor to dispose of them.	Please dispose of this waste yourself or use a licensed contractor. Business operators are required by law to dispose of their own trash. The city does not collect general waste generated by business activities, so please contact a waste disposal contractor. (Some types of trash may be dropped off at incineration facilities for a fee. For more details, contact the Environmental Development Section.) Business operators are also asked to separate and recycle their trash.

- Please take turns keeping the collection point clean.
- Your trash/recyclables will not be collected if you do not follow the rules.
